


### 2. Do you feel your director treats you with respect?




### 4. If you have a problem, do you feel comfortable visiting with your director?








### 6. Do you feel the work in the center is shared equally by all staff?











7. Do you feel the center has enough staff for the number of children?

### 8. Do you feel the parents are greeted and feel welcome by the director?




#### 10. Do your co-workers greet the parents and make them feel welcome?




### 12. Do you like the way the activities for the children are planned?

He doesn't know how to handle kids. Instead of helping put kids to sleep he sits int eh kitchen visiting for a half hour then he takes his half hour break. So he still gets paid to sit around and visit. By who's standards did he come recommended? The staff sees how he works and we are not impressed, he hides from work. (preschool)

I have worked in a lot of different childcare settings, and I have to say I've never seen a director who sits in her office as much as mine at childrens dwelling. I feel that she makes up a lot of rules that are not in our staff handbook. I do have to say that I feel very relieved when she is gone or has left early for her other job, because when she does come out of her office she tells us how to do things that we have been doing here for 8 months and know how to do them already. I feel that myself and my fellow co-workers are much more relaxed and more at ease with the children when our director is absent. (dwelling)
